DAY ONE MONDAY DALLAS ATLANTA

Our guide will be waiting to show us this amazing city by motorcoach. We will visit the World of Coca-Cola, the only place where you can explore the complete story - past, present and future - of the world's best-known brand. The World of Coca-Cola features more than 1,200 artifacts from around the world that, until now, have never been displayed to the public. After lunch at Mary Mac's we will head for Lake Junaluska, our home for 2 nights. The beautiful Lake Junaluska Conference and Retreat Center is owned and operated by the Georgia United Methodist Church Conference. We will have dinner and a relaxing evening in this lovely area. DAY THREE WEDNESDAY BILTMORE

We will begin our day with a visit to the world-famous Biltmore House and Gardens. This French Chateau was built by George Vanderbilt in 1895. Spectacular Christmas décor surround us as we tour the house and grounds that took 6 years and 1,000 men to build. Most of the original furnishings are preserved and give the unique feeling that the family is still in residence. The house contains 250 rooms, 65 fireplaces, 43 bathrooms and 3 kitchens. The Vanderbilt grandchildren continue to benefit the region through employing a 650-person staff to maintain Biltmore House for public enjoyment. Lunch will be on your own in one of the many restaurants on this sprawling property. Breakfast and Dinner will be served in the Lodge. (B D)

DAY FOUR THURSDAY DALLAS

Following breakfast we will head for the Billy Graham Library in Charlotte, North Carolina. Christmas at the Library was voted one of the Top 100 events by the American Bus Association.
